In 1991 two of San Francisco's oldest and most respected medical institutions, Pacific Presbyterian Medical Center and Children's Hospital of San Francisco, merged to form California Pacific Medical Center. In 1998 Davies Medical Center joined and became the center's third campus. In 2007, St. Luke's Hospital became the newest campus. Today, with its 1,304 licensed acute care beds, California Pacific Medical Center is one of the largest private, community-based, not-for-profit teaching medical centers in California. California Pacific Medical Center affiliated with Sutter Health in 1996 and is accredited by the Joint Commission.

Medical Research ~

- Investigation at the California Pacific Medical Center Research Institute (CPMCRI) focuses on the prevention and treatment of disease through biomedical, behavioral and clinical research. Approximately 100 behavioral scientists, biostatisticians, immunologists, molecular biologists and physicians collaborate on research projects.

Sampling of Community Partnerships/Programs ~

In 2006, California Pacific Medical Center provided over \$80.2 million in support of charity care, uncompensated care for publicly sponsored patients and numerous community programs and services such as:

- **Community Clinic Partnership Fund**—\$6 million has been funded to assist with specialty services for the underserved.
- **Health Champions**—A collaborative school based program designed to address health issues.
- **African American Breast Health Program**—Community health education, screening and treatment program for low-income African American women.
- **The City Within**—Career-to-school learning experience for high school juniors and seniors for students who have socio-economic or cultural barriers that might prevent them from pursuing higher education.

- Certified as a Primary Stroke Center and designated a Center of Excellence by the American Society for Bariatric Surgery. (2006)
- California Pacific Medical Center was named one of the top 50 hospitals in the U.S. by the Leapfrog Group, a nonprofit organization that measures hospital quality and safety. (2006)
- Recognized as a “Family Favorite” winner in Bay Area Parent’s 2006 Reader Survey. (2006)
- California Pacific Medical Center won multiple National Health Information Awards, honoring their consumer health information programs. (2005)

Improving Facilities and Access ~

The Sutter Health network of physicians and not-for-profit hospitals will invest billions of dollars over ten years to rebuild, replace and expand much of Northern California’s health care infrastructure. Locally, plans (or completed projects) include:

- Invest in facility upgrades and new technology on all campuses.

Advancing Patient Safety ~

California Pacific Medical Center and our Sutter Health network are raising the bar on patient safety. We are the first network on the West Coast to use early warning software as well as advanced video and electronic monitoring to allow physician specialists to keep an even closer eye on critically ill patients 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continue to be a pioneer in using bar-coding and expert databases to track medication orders to help prevent errors. To further improve clinical outcomes, enhance patient safety and reduce the cost of high-quality care, Sutter Health also is investing \$450 million to deploy an electronic health record (EHR) system as well as \$1.2 billion in a broad range of patient safety initiatives over the next 10 years.
