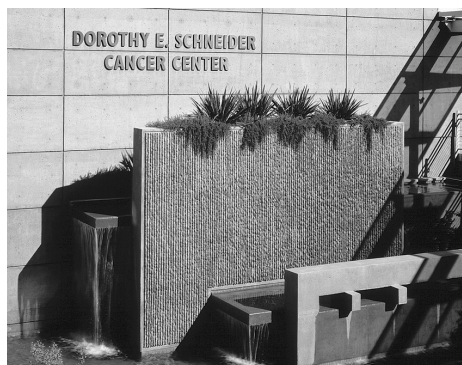

Mills-Peninsula Health Services, a not-for-profit corporation, is celebrating its centennial year in 2007—100 years of caring for the community. Today, Mills-Peninsula operates two community health facilities with a total of 403 inpatient beds. Peninsula Medical Center in Burlingame is an acute care hospital. Mills Health Center in San Mateo provides a wide range of outpatient services, including surgery, rehabilitation, diagnostics and integrative medicine modalities. Mills-Peninsula affiliated with Sutter Health in 1996. It is accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations.

Patient Services ~

The medical center in Burlingame provides inpatient care for most types of illness and injury, including the county's first certified Primary Stroke Center, cardiac and cancer care, mental health and chemical dependency. Special nursing units are available for adult orthopedic, bariatric and pediatric patients. The Family Birth Center offers 15 spacious birthing suites, and a full service emergency department is open 24 hours a day.

The primarily outpatient health center in San Mateo provides the latest capabilities in surgery, treatment and rehabilitative therapies, a new Women's Center, a state-of-the-art renal dialysis center, and the community's most extensive education and wellness promotion programs in the Institute for Health and Healing. The Health Center also provides a 24-hour standby emergency department.

The Dorothy E. Schneider Cancer Center integrates radiation oncology, infusion therapy, diagnostic screening, care management, research, education and the Cancer Registry in a healing environment filled with original art, sunlit spaces, fountains and gardens.

The Women's Center is first on the Peninsula to dedicate a facility to education, diagnosis and treatment of health issues that affect only women or affect women differently than men. It is also first on the Peninsula to offer state-of-the-art digital mammography.

Sampling of Community Partnerships/Programs ~

In 2006, Mills-Peninsula provided \$13.2 million in support of charity care and many community programs and services such as:

- **Senior Focus**—helps older adults maintain health and independence with education and programs such as Alzheimer's and Adult Day Health Care.
- **African American Community Health Advisory Committee**—a community partnership to raise health awareness and improve access to screenings for health issues that disproportionately affect African Americans.

Improving Facilities and Access ~

The Sutter Health network of physicians and not-for-profit hospitals will invest billions of dollars over ten years to rebuild, replace and expand much of Northern California's health care infrastructure. Locally, plans (or completed projects) include:

- Construct new hospital and connected administrative/medical office building to replace existing Peninsula Medical Center
- Expand emergency department by 42 percent
- Construct 800-car parking garage, plus additional street level lots (opened in January 07)
- Include meditation and healing gardens throughout the campus

Advancing Patient Safety ~

Mills-Peninsula Health Services and our Sutter Health network are raising the bar on patient safety. We are the first network on the West Coast to use early warning software as well as advanced video and electronic monitoring to allow physician specialists to keep an even closer eye on critically ill patients 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continue to be a pioneer in using bar-coding and expert databases to track medication orders to help prevent errors. To further improve clinical outcomes, enhance patient safety and reduce the cost of high-quality care, Sutter Health also is investing \$450 million to deploy an electronic health record (EHR) system as well as \$1.2 billion in a broad range of patient safety initiatives over the next 10 years.
