Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa has been providing health care services to residents of Sonoma County for over 130 years. A tradition of quality care by compassionate caregivers has continued over the years as the not-for-profit medical center has expanded and evolved to meet the growing needs of the community it serves. In 2005, Sutter Warrack Hospital merged with Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa to enhance the care they provide, maximize efficiency and streamline operations.

Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa now has 244 licensed beds and serves a population of more than 130,000 people. It provides emergency care to residents of Sonoma County, as well as a portion of Mendocino, Lake, Napa and Marin counties. Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa affiliated with Sutter Health in 1996 and is accredited by the Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations.

## **Patient Services ~**

Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa provides a broad range of comprehensive medical and surgical services including cardiac surgery and interventional cardiology programs. Other services include obstetrics, pediatrics, diagnostic imaging, laboratory, physical and occupational therapy, intensive care, neonatal intensive care, respiratory therapy, breast care services, and a full range of women's health services.

## **Sampling of Community Partnerships/Programs ~**

In 2006, Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa provided \$11.3 million in support of charity care and various community programs and services such as:

- Sweet Success—prenatal program for mothers-to-be with gestational diabetes.
- Parents and Children Together (PACT)—collaborative effort among health care and child care organizations to implement Dr. T. Barry Brazelton's "Touchpoints" child development philosophy county wide in health and child care settings.
- Drive-Thru Flu Shot Clinic—an annual program providing free flu vaccines to community members by Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa registered nurses.
- Healthcare Education Roundtable—a community collaborative established to develop training capacity, economic supports and an effective social marketing campaign to attract young people, especially in communities of color, to the health care professions.
- Latino Health Forum—major sponsorship of annual day-long seminar to update local health and social service providers on issues relevant to caring for the Latino members of our community.

### **Advancing Patient Safety ~**

Sutter Medical Center of Santa Rosa and our Sutter Health network are raising the bar on patient safety. We are the first network on the West Coast to use early warning software as well as advanced video and electronic monitoring to allow physician specialists to keep an even closer eye on critically ill patients 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continue to be a pioneer in using bar-coding and expert databases to track medication orders to help prevent errors. To further improve clinical outcomes, enhance patient safety and reduce the cost of high-quality care, Sutter Health also is investing \$450 million to deploy an electronic health record (EHR) system as well as \$1.2 billion in a broad range of patient safety initiatives over the next 10 years.
