Sutter Davis Hospital is a not-for-profit, 48-bed acute care hospital with a strong outpatient focus. The present facility, a 94,000-square-foot building that anchors a 20-acre medical campus, opened in 1994 after a five-year planning process that included extensive employee and community involvement. The original building was established in 1968 as a for-profit hospital owned by physicians. Sutter Health purchased the hospital in 1981 to ensure residents of Yolo County would continue to have quality medical care into the future. Sutter Davis Hospital is fully accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations.

Services include: 24-hour emergency department, obstetrics, surgery, respiratory therapy, intensive care unit, diagnostic imaging, cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation, occupational health, laboratory and physical therapy.

## Sampling of Community Partnerships/Programs ~

In 2006, Sutter Davis Hospital provided \$5 million in support of charity care and various community programs and services such as:

- **Yolo Health Alliance**—a collaborative effort between Sutter Davis Hospital, Sutter West Medical Group and CommuniCare Health Centers to provide health care to uninsured and low income Yolo County residents.
- **Yolo Perinatal Program**—a collaborative effort between Sutter Davis Hospital, Sutter West Medical Group and CommuniCare Health Centers to provide medical care, nutrition, health education, childbirth preparation and ancillary services to low income and uninsured pregnant women in Yolo County.
- **Creating Healthy Environments for Children**—an intensive neonatal home visiting program designed to reduce child abuse and neglect, increase access to primary preventive services and increase access to immunizations.

### **Building the Workforce ~**

Sutter Health Sacramento Sierra Region has committed more than \$15 million over the next several years to programs at local colleges that will help train and potentially add hundreds of nurses and other health professionals to the Sacramento region's health care job market.

### **Improving Facilities and Access ~**

The Sutter Health network of physicians and not-for-profit hospitals will invest billions of dollars over ten years to rebuild, replace and expand much of Northern California's health care infrastructure. Locally, plans (or completed projects) include:

- Upgraded diagnostic imaging capabilities
- Expand emergency department waiting room, triage area, and hospital lab
- Remodel four operating rooms, add larger waiting areas and a consultation room

### **Advancing Patient Safety ~**

Sutter Davis Hospital and our Sutter Health network are raising the bar on patient safety. We are the first network on the West Coast to use early warning software as well as advanced video and electronic monitoring to allow physician specialists to keep an even closer eye on critically ill patients 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continue to be a pioneer in using bar-coding and expert databases to track medication orders to help prevent errors. To further improve clinical outcomes, enhance patient safety and reduce the cost of high-quality care, Sutter Health also is investing \$450 million to deploy an electronic health record (EHR) system as well as \$1.2 billion in a broad range of patient safety initiatives over the next 10 years.
