Three Sutter hospitals placed among the top 50 in America for overall clinical quality. Additionally, four Sutter hospitals earned Healthgrades' Patient Safety Excellence recognition for 2023. This honor reflects the commitment by Sutter care teams to put patient safety first.



CMS Star Ratings

Sutter hospitals earned an average of 3.71 out of 5 stars from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, above the national average of 3 stars, in 2022. Seven Sutter hospitals earned five stars, reflecting Sutter's aim to provide excellence in care.



Best in Quality and Patient Experience

In 2022, the California Office of the Patient Advocate named several of Sutter's physicians organizations as performing among California's best in quality and patient experience for commercial HMO patients. OPA also recognized Mills-Peninsula Division/Mills-Peninsula Medical Group as California's only physician organization to receive a 5-star "Quality of Medical Care" rating.

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Stamping Out Inequities in Clinical Care Delivery

In a 2022 study, researchers with Sutter's Institute for Advancing Health Equity linked bias in pulse oximeter medical devices used to measure blood oxygen levels with a potential 4.5-hour delay in treatment for Black patients with COVID-19.

Our health equity team collaborates with the UCSF Open Oximetry project and other community providers to **empower and educate patients and their care teams** in better interpreting these device readings.

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Digital Advancements Empower Patients and Improve Outcomes


Sutter's user-friendly digital solutions provide personalized and convenient care, so patients stay connected to their provider teams and can better manage their health.
