


# Wheelchair Spaces at Waiting Room

- A: AT ALL MEDICAL WAITING ROOMS: AT LEAST 5% OF ALL SEATING SPACES SHALL BE SPACES FOR WHEELCHAIRS. IF THE WAITING ROOM SERVES FACILITIES SPECIALIZING IN CONDITIONS THAT AFFECT MOBILITY, 10% IS REQUIRED. EXAMPLE: 12 SEATING SPACES ARE PROVIDED IN PLAN BELOW; 5% OF 12 = .6 WHEELCHAIR SPACES REQUIRED = 1.
- B: WHEELCHAIR SPACES MUST BE 36 INCHES BY 48 INCHES AND SHALL NOT BE OBSTRUCTED BY FURNITURE OR OTHER OBSTACLES. IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO PROVIDE SIGNS OF ANY SORT. NOR IS IT REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ANY MARKING ON THE FLOOR OF ANY SORT.
- C: MAINTAIN A 44 INCH WIDE AISLE, FREE OF ANY FURNITURE OR EQUIPMENT THAT IS LOCATED ADJACENT TO AND NOT OVERLAPPING THE REQUIRED WHEELCHAIR SPACE.
