The Inpatient Spinal Cord Specialty Program at California Pacific Regional Rehabilitation Center delivers a coordinated, outcome driven approach to inpatient acute rehabilitation. Our comprehensive and individualized program focuses on the physical, psychological *and* emotional wellbeing of each patient. Our goal is to facilitate the achievement of functional outcomes that lead to community re-integration and re-engagement in personalized, productive, and meaningful activities.

As part of a tertiary medical center, CPRRC can accommodate adult patients (18 years and older) with the complex medical needs that can be associated with traumatic or non-traumatic spine/spinal cord injuries. Access to hundreds of in-house specialists permits an uninterrupted continuum of care.

Because of comprehensive medical management and specialized therapeutic interventions, state of the art technologies, integrative therapy services, and as reflected by our outcomes, we are recognized as an industry innovator and a center of excellence.
