The average age of the patients at Sutter Rehabilitation Institute was 70 years old, with the youngest being 16* and the oldest being 103.1

- 7% of patients were younger than 44.
- 22% of patients were between the age of 45 and 64.
- 29% of patients were between the age of 65 and 74.
- 43% of patients were older than 75.

* One adolescent was treated at Sutter Rehabilitation Institute in 2021.

Returning to the Community

The ability to return home, or to a home-like setting, is the primary goal of inpatient rehabilitation. A high rate of return to the community means that most people progress

enough to return home and that families and caregivers are trained to provide any needed care.

Sutter Rehabilitation Institute's rate of return to the community is 88% compared to the national benchmark of 81%.1

Readmission to an Acute Hospital

Sometimes a change in a person's condition requires readmission to an acute hospital for further medical care. In 2021, 6.4% of patients from Sutter Rehabilitation Institute were admitted to an acute hospital due to a change in medical condition, which is well below the state benchmark of 7.7% and the national benchmark of 8.9%.1
